

# FERRARI HYBRID CHARGING

#### FERRARI PLUG-IN HYBRID VEHICLES

Whether away or at home in the privacy of your garage, proper charging is essential to preserving the excellence and longevity of your Ferrari plug-in hybrid vehicle.

By following these guidelines, you'll maintain optimal battery health and ensure your Ferrari is always primed for the road ahead.





# PARKING WITHOUT ACCESS TO CHARGING EQUIPMENT

#### The vehicle must remain charged at all times.

If you plan to park your vehicle unconnected to charging equipment, please ensure the battery has sufficient power. If the battery runs low, connect to a charger promptly to prevent critical discharge levels.



# CHARGING WITH THE GAS ENGINE

Switch e-Manettino to **Qualifying** mode 30 minutes before parking to boost the charge. Drive calmly, avoiding full engine power, and the Ferrari gasoline engine will recharge the vehicle's high-voltage battery.

### PARKING FOR AN EXTENDED TIME

When parking for longer than two weeks, please enable **Long Parking Mode**. The system automatically manages battery levels to maintain the ideal charge and prevent premature battery aging.

Activation Steps

- 1 Select SETTINGS on the dashboard
- 2 Select CAR
- 3 Select LONG PARKING MODE



### HOW TO CHARGE

Please note, charging procedures are the same for both service and standard wall sockets.



### **Connect the Charger**

- ① Plug the cable into the electrical outlet and insert the connector firmly into the vehicle charging port.
- ② Confirm the lights on the charging equipment are illuminated.
- Check the green symbol and status on the vehicle dashboard to monitor charging progress.
- 4 Lock the vehicle using the key fob.



### Disconnect the Charger

- 1 Unlock the vehicle using the key fob.
- 2 Disconnect the charger from the charging port.
- 3 Unplug the charger from the electrical outlet.
- 4 Close the charging flap.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not use extension cords, power strips, or multi-socket adapters with the Ferrari charging system.
